It is the foundation of a universal language that speaks to new generations, a channel through which utopia becomes attractive, alive, and participatory. By integrating transmedia storytelling, the mechanisms of Live Action Role-Playing (LARP) in Alternate Reality Games (ARG), elements of science fiction, and persistent world architectures, I create a unique immersive experience. My metaverse is therefore a serious game, a total work of art, a soft diplomacy strategy, and a civilizational project.

I invite you, as **representatives of our institutions**, to consider this **profound transformation** with the utmost attention and to participate, with full awareness, in this **historic endeavor**.

Whether you believe it or not, I assure you that government bodies have been studying my proposals for years, in the shadows, far from media spotlights and official statements.

Torreblanca is today, by strategic decision, the beating heart of a global movement, and you can be its first allies.

# A - A new European Reconquista is being born in Spain, from Torreblanca, Castellón

The Reconquista of Small Towns and Villages, also called Reconquista EL4DEV or Reconquista 3.0, is the cultural movement initiated by Paul Elvere DELSART from Spain, a country with characteristics conducive to the emergence of a project of this magnitude. This movement aims to gradually and massively unite around a symbolic and inspiring work of sociocultural and institutional change: the Green Empire of the East and the West, also known as the EL4DEV Confederation. It relies on mechanisms such as the EL4DEV program, LE PAPILLON SOURCE, The Municipalities Counter-Attack, EL4DEV societal diplomacy, and international artistic and intellectual cooperation events. He proposes a Reconquista of Small Towns and Villages in Spain, southern Europe, and subsequently across Europe and other countries worldwide; a project focused on rural renewal, local autonomy, and peaceful social transformation, taking the town of Torreblanca, in the province of Castellón, Spain, as its starting point. The ambition is to restore vitality and sovereignty to forgotten rural towns through participatory governance, an ecological currency, experimental and educational living infrastructures, and collaborative influence on a transnational scale.

This project seeks to expand beyond Spanish borders, initially toward Portugal, France, Italy, and Greece, as part of a civilization-rebuilding approach based on cooperation, beauty, and exemplary practices. It is therefore not a military reconquest, but an intellectual and local, non-violent movement aimed at reinventing territorial sovereignty starting at the municipal level. The Reconquista of Small Towns and Villages is a civil, cultural, ecological, and participatory project, announced from Spain during the summer of 2025 (July and August) and accompanied by numerous online publications, including eight e-books available in French, English, and Spanish, entitled: EL4DEV – The Reconquista of Small Towns and Villages, Reconquista EL4DEV – The Rural Empire, Reconquista 3.0 – The Empire of city-states, The new global migration pact, Henry HARPER – The Green Emperor, GREEN COIN EL4DEV – Planetary monetary network, BIG SMART DATA EL4DEV – Social network of peace, and THE MUNICIPALITIES COUNTER-ATTACK – Planetary cooperative mechanism.

In these short works, positioned at the crossroads of social fiction, political essay, and strategic guide, Paul Elvere DELSART, also known by the name Henry HARPER (his avatar's name), invites the reader on a peaceful epic. He outlines the contours of a concrete civilizational project in which each chapter becomes an act of regeneration. The work combines symbolic narrative and operational strategy, elevating rurality to the role of a driving force for global transformation. Through these manifestos, the author suggests that the rebirth of our civilization could arise from small, forgotten towns and villages, placing Torreblanca at the heart of a new ecological, ethical, social, intellectual, and highly entrepreneurial empire, one in which each small town and village finds its place as a radiant city-state (autonomous, self-managed, green, and interconnected).

B – The Green Empire of the East and the West or EL4DEV Confederation – A cultural ecosystem and an immersive social fiction

I am Paul Elvere DELSART, founder of the **EL4DEV program** and the **EL4DEV Confederation**, also known as the **Green Empire of the East and the West**. From **Torreblanca**, Spain, I am initiating a movement that some might call a peaceful revolution, but which I proudly name the **Reconquista of Small Towns and Villages**. This dynamic is part of a broader framework: the **EL4DEV Second Renaissance Movement**. A renaissance that is neither academic nor museum-like, but alive, transdisciplinary, rooted in experience and the living world. It appeals to sensitivity, spirituality, collective intelligence, the poetry of places, and the enthusiasm of youth. It **rejects the planned obsolescence of cultures, knowledge, and human beings**. Everything begins here, in Torreblanca, a modest Mediterranean coastal town in the province of Castellón, within the Valencian Autonomous Community of Spain. This is no coincidence. Spain will unite with its sister nation, Portugal, and then with France, Italy, and Greece. An ancient yet renewed alliance, born from a shared awareness: the duty to repair the world, not through force, but through cooperation, beauty, creation, and example.

Thus, through the Reconquista of Small Towns and Villages (Reconquista EL4DEV or Reconquista 3.0), we are not merely rebuilding local economies: we are rewriting the codes of a new civilization. ### C - The inter-municipal cooperation sub-program 'THE MUNICIPALITIES COUNTER-ATTACK'

The sub-program **THE MUNICIPALITIES COUNTER-ATTACK** (in Spanish, **EL CONTRAATAQUE DE LOS MUNICIPIOS**, and in French, **LES COMMUNES CONTRE-ATTAQUENT**) is part of the ambitious global societal transformation program called **EL4DEV**, designed by **Paul Elvere DELSART**, founder of the Think and Do Tank **LE PAPILLON SOURCE EL4DEV**. This sub-program focuses specifically on **inter-municipal cooperation** and targets **small towns and villages**, particularly those with fewer than 5,000 inhabitants, although it also extends to those with up to 7,000 inhabitants.

This sub-program proposes a **new form of inter-municipal cooperation** based on **social and solidarity** criteria, aiming to promote **financial autonomy**, **local self-financing**, and the **international role** of these small territorial entities. The **Vegetal Calderas** built under the program function as multifunctional ecological towers that generate atmospheric humidity, emit beneficial electromagnetic fields, serve as habitats for local wildlife and pollinators, and are used for tourism, agriculture, education, and scientific purposes. These structures form the core of the **LE PAPILLON SOURCE** complexes, which are educational and agro-climatic parks designed to **promote sustainability**, **experiential learning**, **and food self-sufficiency**.

The Vegetal Calderas are not merely autonomous structures with high ecological and educational value. They are also designed as the fundamental links of a strategic territorial network: the Bioclimatic Corridors, whose function goes far beyond simple local development. Once activated by the installation of the Vegetal Calderas, these corridors become vectors of large-scale climate transformation, contributing to the creation of artificial Flying Rivers, a phenomenon inspired by the natural water cycle and atmospheric biogeography.

This moisture released into the air is then carried by the winds, forming **true atmospheric flows of water vapor**, comparable to the natural 'Flying Rivers' observed in the Amazon rainforest.

Beyond its technical aspect, THE MUNICIPALITIES COUNTER-ATTACK has a profound diplomatic and geopolitical dimension, promoting a form of decentralized diplomacy called EL4DEV societal diplomacy, which fosters international collaboration between municipalities without the intermediation of central governments. The intention is for these municipal groupings to become the driving force of a new, more horizontal, transparent, and ethical governance, where small communities are transformed into key actors in regional and global development.

The sub-program also has a **strong educational and cultural dimension**. The **participatory, intellectual, and artistic events** organized within the sub-program **mobilize local talents** and **generate creative dynamics** capable of **inspiring other territories**. In this way, the model becomes replicable at an international scale, particularly in regions with **similar climatic, social or economic characteristics**.

In summary, THE MUNICIPALITIES COUNTER-ATTACK is not merely a sub-program for participatory funding of ecological infrastructures; it is a comprehensive strategy to reorganize territorial development through municipal cooperation, strengthen local sovereignty, decentralize diplomacy, distribute wealth, and transform the Mediterranean region (and eventually the world) into a living laboratory of cohesion, resilience, and shared prosperity. But this imaginative phase is only a prelude. For Torreblanca is not just a stage: it is also the tangible starting point of a global metamorphosis. In a second phase, the town becomes the first real stronghold of a structured, multidisciplinary, cooperative, and decentralized global movement. It is here that a new geopolitical bloc emerges: the Mediterranean Societal Union. It is here that the first modern Templar Commanderies bearing the LE PAPILLON SOURCE label are established. It is here that the first Vegetal Calderas rise, these vertical, life-filled vegetal structures acting as climatic, educational, and community generators.

**Torreblanca is the prototype, the laboratory, the reproducible model**. Through this town, I open a new path, founded on **ethical post-capitalism**, the **sovereignty of small municipalities**, **transnational cooperation between peoples** and generations, and the **revitalization of the rural world**. The projects of educational tourist towns and agroclimatic vegetal complexes labeled LE PAPILLON SOURCE, the sub-program for decentralized inter-municipal

empowerment and cooperation called THE MUNICIPALITIES COUNTER-ATTACK, the Societal Economic Interest Groups **giving rise to new geopolitical blocs**, as well as the viral dynamics of intellectual, environmental, social, and spiritual development modeled in the information system called Big Smart Data EL4DEV, all take shape and substance here.

What I am establishing in Torreblanca is a **radical rethinking of development logics**. It is the **Reconquista of marginalized and forgotten small towns and villages**. E - This project could serve as an interesting case study for universities, political parties, think tanks, NGOs, and governments.

I propose an **alternative scenario** and share the **operational framework for transforming society**. This approach can be compared with more conventional models.

The project is a blend of radical ecology, spirituality, citizen participation, and local/inter-municipal governance, offering an alternative to traditional development paradigms.

It includes **concrete proposals**, ideal for studying the implementation of public policies, territorial planning, participatory or municipal financing and rural development.

The project also opens **avenues of research** in political philosophy, environmental ethics, sociology of values, territorial development, international cooperation, etc.

#### Specific themes that can be explored as case studies

Possible directions for academic or policy-oriented studies:

- **Study of innovative local governance:** how municipalities can co-design ambitious social projects, share benefits, pool resources, and form inter-municipal alliances, etc.
- Alternative financing models and social economy: exploring the proposed economic models, the concept of Economic Interest Groups (EIGs), redistribution, and the co-ownership of infrastructures.
- **Urban planning and ecological rurality approaches:** the Vegetal Calderas, bioclimatic corridors, ecological and agroclimatic tourism, etc., as alternatives to conventional urban development or mass tourism.
- Ethics and values in societal projects: the role of spirituality, living systems, and energetic consciousness in political or social initiatives.
